

It's easy to apply...

- Contact your local Saskatchewan Agriculture, Food & Rural Revitalization Specialist 1-888-452-5558 to do an initial screening assessment of eligibility. They will direct you to your local Regional Community college.
- Contact your local Regional College and indicate that you are interested in the Self Employment Program.. They will complete a Learning Plan Assessment.
- Regional College submits the Learning Plan Assessment to Saskatchewan Agriculture and Food for approval. Note that the Learning Plan Assessment can take up to 15-20 business days.
- The Regional College will contact Global Infobrokers to confirm the placement and finalize start and end dates for the program.
- On receipt of the referral, Global Infobrokers, will contact you. You will be required to complete our assessment package prior to your interview.
- After the interview and assessment, a report will be written and provided to you and your consultant with a recommendation for you to enter the training program on the specified dates.
